Take some time to get to know each other by answering this question:

\* What has been your experience of LENT?

"Lent is the season of repentance – a chance to acknowledge our limitations, our humanity, our failures, our sins and recognize our utter dependence on God for our every breath." Kate Bowler

Read Matthew 4:1-11

**Test 1:** *If you are the Son of God... then?* (Matthew 4:1-4)

Jesus' testing regarding his identity is a common human experience.

This comes right after the baptism of Jesus (See Matthew 3:17) this is when the heavens opened up and spoke these words: "This is my Son in whom I love, with him I am well pleased." **Jesus' circumstances do not define his identity.** 

Who are you really? Take some time to remind each other or who you are, that you are loved, and created in the image of the Divine.

**Test 2:** *Does God really care for you?* (Matt. 4:5-7)

The tester, the tempter, the accuser is using scripture to try and manipulate Jesus.

Side Note: (Scripture can be used to deceive - Jesus needs to be at the center of our interpretation.)

**Jesus reveals he is the Son of God through trust not tricks**. (Psalm 91)

How do we trust God in our context?

**Test 3:** How will Jesus rule? (Matt. 4:8-10)

Jesus rules as a servant to God and a servant to others. (Matt. 20:28)

What are our expectations of how God rules? How does that shape how we live?

## A Benediction for this Beautiful, Limited day - by Kate Bowler

Blessed are we who see the impossibility of solving today. It can't be done.

God, there are lists on lists and errands on errands and a taste, like tin in our mouths, of the unfinishedness—the imperfectability—of our lives.
